LINCOLN CONTINENTAL TOWN CAR VS. CADILLAC SEDAN DEVILLE WITH D'ELEGANCE OPTION...

1. THE QUIETNESS COMPETITION

- Ford Vehicle Development Engineers ran a cycle of 15 passenger compartment sound level tests on the two contenders. Tests were made at varying speeds over three types of surfaces: a smooth concrete road with expansion joints, a smooth asphalt road, and a rugged Belgian block road.
- The Results: Lincoln had quieter readings in 12 out of the 15 tests conducted.

2. THE ROOMINESS COMPETITION

 The Challenge: Ford Motor Company Packaging Engineers made a comparative evaluation of the passenger compartments of the two contenders using industry-accepted standards.

• The Results:

- Lincoln has a wider door entrance than Cadillac.
- In the Lincoln, the windshield is farther away from front seat passengers . . . giving a feeling of greater spaciousness compared to Cadillac.
- Lincoln's front compartment leg room provides more knee clearance under the steering wheel than Cadillac.
- Lincoln has more effective shoulder room — front and rear — because its armrests don't displace passengers as far inboard as the Cadillac's.
- In the rear compartment, Lincoln offers 1.1" more head and leg room . . . and 5.2" more hip room over Cadillac.
- Deep Well Trunk Design: a two-suiter fits easily through the Lincoln trunk opening and can be stored upright. The same luggage has to be tilted to go through the Cadillac opening — and must be stored on its side.

 4 CUBIC FEET MORE SPACE IN THE
 PASSENGER COMPARTMENT THAN
