

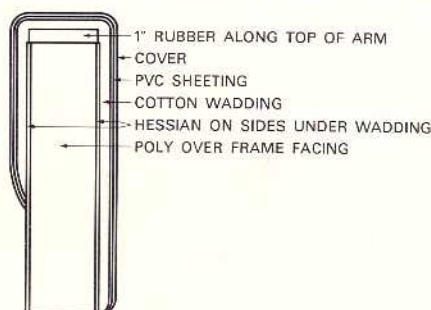

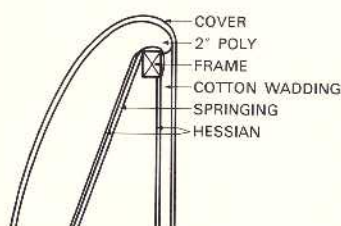
1. THE INSIDE STORY

This is why you should never judge an upholstered chair by its cover. (Most other manufacturers would be afraid to show you this much.) Parker frames for instance. Morticed and tenoned under-frames with interlocking dowels on every double joint. Rigid, 'seasoned' timber. And when you sit, you sink, into inches of comfort. Beneath it, a coil-sprung base supported by another layer of horizontal no-sag springs, or tough, resilient Pirelli webbing! Now take a look at what goes into making the backrests and arms.

TYPICAL BACK REST SECTION (FROM SIDE)

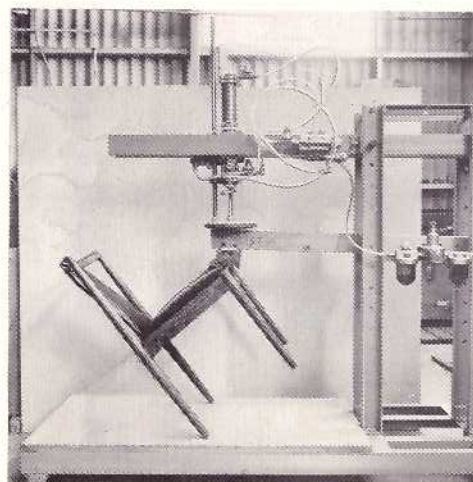

2. A TEST OF STRENGTH

Who says a chair has to be heavy to be strong! Not us. Parker build strength and rigidity into the design of all their chairs. The choice of the correct type of joint and the exact angle of rails and legs is important. Every new design is thoroughly tested under maximum stress conditions

until our designers are completely satisfied that each section will withstand a lifetime of use—whatever the conditions.



Of course, sometimes other people design their chairs to look just like ours. The big difference is our claims carry a lot of weight—*your guarantee of satisfaction.*

3. A PARKER EXCLUSIVE

Only Parker tables have *moulded* edges. Only Parker craftsmen care enough to ignore cheap veneer trimmings and give their tables solid teak edges; shaped to enhance their looks and lengthen their lives.

4. IDENTICAL TREES DO NOT GROW

Differences in colour and grain are natural characteristics produced by nature in all woods—differences which create an individual beauty and distinction for every piece of Parker furniture. We use the world's best teak from the forests of Burma and Thailand. Look for these natural timbers, a distinguishing mark of Parker furniture.

5. THE PARKER OIL FINISH

Be sure to keep the timbers oiled, and your Parker furniture will stay alive forever. About three times a year, or whenever you might wish to remove stains or heat marks, apply oil liberally with a soft cloth, and rub with fine steel wool. Always rub 'with the grain' and

be sure to remove surplus oil with a clean cloth. No other waxes, polishes or creams should be used in addition to the oil. (check with Parker for recommended oils.)

6. WOOL FABRICS

Exclusive to Parker. We choose the yarn, the weave, the weight, the colours—colours produced by our own designers. High-key colours, muted colours. Parker pure new wool fabrics are DRI-SIL treated to shed liquids. They're fabrics to live with today, and for a lifetime.

7. THE OBVIOUS DIFFERENCE

Hand-craftsmanship is not a lost art at Parker. We invite you to look closely at the smooth curves and almost undetectable joins in every piece of Parker furniture. This fine hand-finishing is the work of Australian tradesmen, many of European descent, still prac-

tising skills handed down through generations. Another reason why your Parker furniture will still look new many years from now.
