IT systems are healthy and the future is bright.

A cure for information overload

An efficient hospital relies on far more than just its hardworking doctors and nurses — solid IT systems are also crucial to the smooth running of a medical establishment. Today, information technology plays a crucial part in helping NHS (National Health Service) staff to effectively manage their increasingly demanding roles.

In order to ensure a reliable, efficient service for its staff users and, ultimately, effective care for its patients, the Chelsea and Westminster Hospital (London) needed to change the way it managed its own internal data. Specifically, Chelsea and Westminster Healthcare, an NHS Trust, needed a scalable, flexible and resilient storage and backup infrastructure to support their e-mail, file and print, and financial support systems. It was also important that this infrastructure supported cluster-based technology.

By installing a StorageTek D173 disk subsystem and L40 tape library into a storage area network (SAN), the hospital has centralised its data storage and backup, increased the availability of its data and minimised the management time and cost of its Windows 2000 servers. This is the first major step toward building the information core for the NHS, standardising across platforms and meeting the NHS Plan laid down by the Department of Health. Imminent applications that will benefit from this SAN infrastructure include a GP referral letter document management system and a retinal image EPR system.

Opened in 1993, the Chelsea and Westminster Hospital provides general medical and surgical care to patients in the west of London, as well as specialist services to patients from across Britain. The Trust reviewed and treated 260,000 outpatients, 80,000 Accident and Emergency attenders, 30,000 emergency admissions and 26,000 elective admissions in 2002/2003.

For the past four years, the Chelsea and Westminster Hospital has held its e-mail, and file and print data across a number of NT workgroup servers, each in different departments.

Explaining the growing IT challenge, Bill Gordon, assistant director of customer and technical services at Chelsea and Westminster Hospital, said, "Over the last few years we have seen a continual growth in data, which was proving more and more difficult to manage and back up across the numerous disparate servers it was held on. It became obvious that we needed to centralise the storage of our data, not just to comply with the NHS Executive mandate, but also in order to maximise operational efficiency for our 2,500 hospital staff."

Chelsea and Westminster turned to value added reseller and integrator Datapoint Consulting Group (DCG), a specialist storage and backup company, to audit and assess their storage and backup/recovery needs. After a full assessment of the environment, issues and requirements, DCG recommended implementing a storage area network (SAN) infrastructure utilising StorageTek's disk and tape technologies. DCG has worked in strong partnership with StorageTek and Chelsea and Westminster Hospital to commission and develop the complete SAN infrastructure.

The solution incorporated a StorageTek D173 disk subsystem and L40 tape library to deliver optimum efficiency in a SAN configuration. The SAN links the storage platforms into four new Windows 2000 server cluster nodes and a Sun V880 enterprise server running Oracle Financials. VERITAS NetBackup software was deployed and integrated by DCG to centralise the backup function for the enterprise. The total solution is also future-proofed as it provides an easy upgrade path for both media as the information management burden grows.

Gordon said, "We felt that StorageTek delivered the best technology to support our needs, both in terms of its flexibility and scalability, and also due to the ease of management the StorageTek solution delivered. We now have a robust, centrally managed backup resource that is efficient to use and manage — exactly what we need to support us as the hospital increases its reliance on technology."
