Problem

Lack of visibility into remote sites and a low bandwidth environment

The company has three large data centers, which contain 70 terabytes of storage, use EMC Symmetrix and CLARiiON systems, Brocade switches, IBM AIX and Windows NT servers, and multiple databases. The storage administration team was located in one data center, but required greater visibility into operations at the other two data centers. In seeking a solution that would deliver end-to-end visibility of the entire infrastructure, the company needed to find a tool that would work efficiently in its low bandwidth environment. In addition, they wanted a cost-effective solution that would be vendor-neutral, freeing managers to make future purchasing decisions based upon a particular application's needs and not solely upon a vendor's assessment of the company's needs.

Consolidated storage management and a unique low-overhead architecture
